Raj Chetty **Improving Equality of Opportunity in America: New Lessons from Big Data**

Raj Chetty is a Professor of Economics at Stanford University. He is the recipient of a MacArthur “Genius” Fellowship and the John Bates Clark Medal. His work on taxation, social insurance, and education has influenced both academic research and government policy. Much of his current research focuses on understanding the causes and consequences of inequality and intergenerational social mobility. In particular, his work sheds light on improving economic opportunities for disadvantaged children.
